PUBLIC MARKETS, WEIGHTS AND MEASURES 24.01

24.01 CITY SEALER OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES. (11.05) A City Sealer of Weights and Measures shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council for a term of 2 years. He shall receive such compensation as shall be determined by the City Council. He shall have the powers and duties granted to and required of such officer by Ch. 98, Wis. Stats.

24.02 WEIGHING OF COAL. All coal offered for sale and delivered within the City, except in carload lots and in lots of less than 500 pounds, shall first be weighed at a State approved scale. The weigher at such scale shall give to the owner thereof or his agent a written ticket with his signature attached thereto of the quantity of coal. A scale shall not be deemed a State approved scale for purposes of this chapter unless the same shall have been sealed by the State Department of Agriculture which shall certify such sealing to the City Council.

24.03 COMMODITIES TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC MARKET ONLY. Wood, hay, grain, and all other commodities offered for sale in open market and upon wagons and other vehicles, except as provided in Sec.24.02, shall only be exposed for sale at the City Market, or at such places as the Council may from time to time direct by ordinance or resolution. Any person who shall cause or permit his wagon or other vehicle so loaded to stand upon any street, alley or public ground of the City, after being notified by any police officer to remove the same to the place designated for such purpose by the Council shall be guilty of violating this chapter.

24.04 CITY MARKET LOCATION. The property described as North 100 feet of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Goss' Subdivision of the City of Sparta, and now owned by the City shall be the City Market Place.

24.10 PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be subject to the penalty as provided in Sec.25.04 of this Municipal Code.
