June 6, 2016

Chairman Jim Church called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

Kris Brieske expressed concerns about the parks not being trimmed especially before an upcoming tournament. Brad's crew consisted of people that were still in school and school was not out. He will try to get people that can work after hours or start earlier in the year.

A motion was made by Kevin Schmitz and seconded by Tom Brown to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of minutes from the April 18, 2016 meeting, Park & Rec Director's monthly reports for May and June, monthly bills for April and River Run report. Motion carried 6-0.

Reinhard Mueller presented the Board with a list of suggested names that could be used to name the Amundson Park Bridge. He thought it would be a good idea to start thinking of a name. If anyone else has any other suggestions, just let the Park Board know.

The family of Jack Harr would like to purchase a bench in honor of Jack. A suggestion was that this bench might be able to replace a worn out one in Memorial Park. **A motion was made by Kris Brieske and seconded by Kevin Schmitz to let the family of Jack Harr move forward to purchase a bench and place it where Brad deems fit. Motion carried 6-0.**

Ryan Hutson is requesting that the Board approve the donation of 2 junior golf memberships for the Singh Grewal Memorial Tournament on July 16th. **A motion was made by Tom Brown and seconded by Wil Calkins to approve the donation of 2 junior golf memberships for the Singh Grewal Memorial Tournament on July 16th. Motion carried 6-0.**

Alli Karrels explained what the "little free libraries" program was all about. She would like to see if this program could be set up in the Sparta Parks. The structures are filled with books and people can borrow the books and then bring them back when they are done. The library staff is willing to help with this and could provide some books as they receive donation of books during the year. Brad could contact some organizations to see if they could build these structures as a project or get a price on how much these would cost to build and then be placed in a visible part of certain parks. There is a registration fee to get our area listed with the "Little Free Libraries" program. **A motion was made by Kris Brieske and seconded by Tom Brown to have Brad move forward with "Little Free Libraries" and use his discretion as far as cost according to what he has available in his budget. Motion carried 6-0.**

Brad received two proposals from T. J. Emmerich Associations regarding an irrigation system for the 18 hole River Run golf course and one for the four baseball fields at Memorial Park. The proposal for the golf course shows 6 phases and with a total cost of \$33,000.00. The proposal for the baseball fields was requested in case we were able to connect these with the golf course. This was the only irrigation consultant that Brad could find in Wisconsin. The GPS mapping phase and the preliminary design phase

would need to be started and finalized before mid-August if this system is to be completed by next Spring. **A motion was made by Tom Brown and seconded by Wil Calkins to consider the proposal for the irrigation system from T. J. Emmerich Association, Inc. at the cost of \$33,000 unless Brad can negotiate a price on the single-row system and that there be more detailed information written out in the proposal as to number of visits or any extra costs that may be incurred. Motion carried 6-0.**

Items for future consideration were:

Parks & Recreation Director's Report
July 11, 2016

Adult Softball League

Leagues have been going very good thus far and the teams have been very competitive! At this time we have only had a partial rain out of games and hopefully will not have any make-up games to play. The new umpires have all been doing a great job!

Summer Baseball/Softball

Our softball program has continued to grow over the past couple of years and this year we have a U12, U14 and 2 High School teams. We also have a team in a U12 Cooperative league with Tomah, Brookwood and Royal. The coop league has been going very good for the teams and gives the girls a chance to play other teams in a less competitive format. The 10 under team has been playing against Tomah each week and will also do some scrimmages against our own team. We started practicing about a month earlier this year and it has helped with the development of the girls and getting them ready for games.

Our in house baseball program has been running for a couple weeks now. We only had around 24 kids in the program this season. This is just enough kids to try and run a league. We have divided the teams into 4 different squads A, B, C, and D. We then take 2 squads each week and combine them to make a team. This allows us to have them play a "different" team each week. AB vs. CD, BD vs. AC, etc.

Pee Wee Ragball/Rookie Ragball

Both programs have been going very good this year. We have 6 teams in our Pee Wee Ragball program and have had 2 weeks of games so far. It is amazing the progress the players have made in just 3 weeks of the program. Rookie Ragball has had 3 weeks of practice so far this season. The kids have been learning a lot and we have some great volunteers helping to coach the program. Century Foods has again sponsored shirts for both programs this year. They have been a great sponsor for the program every season!

Pool

The pool has been very busy this year and the guards have been working hard. We have switched our PH control over to a CO2 system this year. We use CO2 gas to lower the PH of the pool. This system had a little bit of a learning curve to it and some adjustments that we had to make early in the season. This system is significantly safer than using the muriatic acid that we have used in the past. We do still have acid as a back up in the event the CO2 isn't able to keep up with a high bather load on busy days. We have had to add acid a couple times this summer.

We had our first Flick and Float and had around 90 people attend the event. We were hoping for a larger crowd for the night. Most if not all of those that attended were season pass holders. This is something that we should review for next year whether or not we should allow season passes or charge an admission.

We have added some healthier options to the menu in the concession stand with some fresh fruit which has been successful for us. Food sales continue to be good in the concession stand and the CABS are doing a great job keeping up with the busy times.

We had our state inspection this past week and we got a 100%! There were NO violations found at the pool and no recommendations for changes.

We continue to struggle a bit with some of the staff at the pool showing up for scheduled shifts, not doing their cleaning duties at the end of the shift and forgetting to punch in or punch out. We continue to encourage them and provide guidance to them to improve their performance.

Men's July Tournament

We have only 24 teams registered for the tournament this year and will be rescheduling the tournament based upon the teams that we have registered. We will end up with 6 teams in "A", 12 teams in "B" and 6 teams in the "C" bracket. Based upon feedback from players in the tournaments many teams have been going to other tournaments this weekend because of high payouts. I have done some work with the budget and will be changing our payouts for both men's tournaments next season. We will reduce the number of umpires we have for all the bracket games and only use a 2 man umpire crew for the 1-4th place games. This will save us about \$1100 in umpire fees which I will put back into the payouts for the tournaments.

Women's Softball Tournament

We only have 19 teams registered at this time which is very low. I have been spreading the word on social media and have posted our tournament on several softball web pages and web forums. Direct mailings went out to all teams that have played with us in the past 5 years along with flyers being placed in the mailings for all the Men's tournaments. I have called around to several other cities regarding women's softball and they all are experiencing lower numbers of women's softball teams.

Summer Gymnastics

Day camps have been going great. I see the kids outside playing games, working on gymnastics skills and doing community service around the community.

The regular evening classes are traditionally a bit smaller in the summer months but have enough participants in each class to keep them all open.

Adult Fitness Classes

Classes are going well. Attendance is generally a little lower in the summer. We cancelled a couple of the classes because of low registrations which is pretty normal for the summer. We have added several classes at the pool that have all filled up. These are great additions to our summer schedules.

Golf Course

The course has been in pretty good shape this season. We have had a full crew of employees almost all summer and they have been working hard to keep the course in good shape.

Emmerich irrigation was scheduled to start last week but he had to reschedule due to personal problems. He should be out in the next week or so to do the GPS data work and get starting on the irrigation design.

Misc.

The board walk in Amundson Park has been started. There was a large tree that we had to remove before construction could get into full swing.

I will be getting bids for the privacy fence at The Greens within the next week.

I am working to get the flags installed at Evans Bosshard Park. The hardware is missing on one of the flag poles that are near the river.

We have been either removing or repairing some of the benches in the parks along the waterways.

We have done some trimming, mowing and filling of holes around the Osborne Drive house. The engineers spent a day look at the facility and will hopefully have a full report for the next board meeting. We have removed items that we felt were of value and have placed them up for auction on www.wisconsin surplus.com web site.
