A motion was made by Kevin Brueggeman and seconded by Alli Karrels to deny the bartender license application for Jesse Galaviz and "Class B" retail license for Burrito Real Cinco de Mayo Restaurant as this person would be the agent. 




2015/2016 Year to Date Calls for Service




2015/2016 Year to Date Citations & Arrests

Running Total 2015/2016




Major Crime Comparison
January 2015/2016




January 2016 Traffic Stops

Ref: Squad & Body Video Cameras

Dear Council Members,

Sparta Police have six (6) squad cars equipped with video cameras that were purchased around 2009. The cameras are made by Digital Ally with old technology. The picture quality is so terrible, that you can't read license plate numbers or identify people. The District Attorney is complaining about the video quality making his job harder in court. The cameras are expensive to repair and constantly need repair work.

The Officers currently do not have department issued body cameras. This means that if the Officers are not standing in front of the squad car, their contacts with the public are not being recorded. In this age of technology, People are expecting that all contacts with Police are being recorded for the protection of both parties.

I got quotes from Baycom (Arbitrator), Taser and Watch Guard for squad & body video cameras. I contacted other Law Enforcement agencies for their recommendations. I talked to Digital Ally about up-grading to a better system but they want me to pay new price without a trade in and their customer service plus product quality has been terrible, so I didn't receive a written quote form Digital Ally.

I am asking to purchase 6 new squad and 8 body cameras from Watch Guard for a price of \$50,421.00. They will divide the cost into 2 equal payments of \$26,748 this year (2016) and \$26,748 next year (2017). The finance cost is \$3,075.00 for a split payment. This will make the total cost of equipment to be \$53,496.00. The cost to remove and install new cameras in the 6 squads by a local company will be between \$1,500- \$2,000 total.

Watch Guard is highly recommended by the Monroe County Sheriff, District Attorney and West Salem Police in this area. Watch Guard also had the lowest quote.
