Jim Church called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Matthew Hoffland to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of minutes of the regular meeting on February 5, 2024 and monthly bills for February and March. Motion carried 6-0

Brad Gilbertson presented the Parks and Recreation Director's report for February and March. Brad stated they filled the vacancy in the Parks and Recreation Department. Nolan Hertel is a grad student, who is finishing his Master's Degree in May.

Brad presented the Maintenance Supervisor Report for February and March. Brad stated they have talked to US Silica to sample our sand to theirs in hopes of using their product in the sand traps as a cost savings.

Robert Arnold represented Sparta Area Fire District. He states that their fundraising efforts for this year were earmarked for new radios and a new gear extractor, along with a donation to a local fundraiser. They presented the Park Board with a \$2,700 donation for the Memorial Park All-Abilities Playground.

Reinhard Mueller stated the project will move forward with a slight modification of location due to a light pole line being in the way. He anticipates they will begin excavation this weekend. He stated that the Sparta Area Chamber of Commerce is seeking donations for the construction costs by providing naming rights for various "wings" and areas of the building.

Matthew Hoffland inquired about the status of the Evans-Bosshard Park parking lot. Todd stated the park shelters are booked solid throughout the early summer months. He anticipates an August bid timeframe and completion in the fall.

Mark Sund stated they will be bringing forward a policy for the use of the golf course while it is closed.

A motion was made by Matthew Hoffland and seconded by Josh Lydon to adjourn at 6:32 p.m. Motion carried 6-0.
