Each of the Department Heads got up and gave an overview of what their department has been doing and what items their department may need in the upcoming year.

When the Department Heads were done speaking, the Council members placed their stickers on the items that they felt were most important for the upcoming year to be accomplished. These were tallied and listed in order of the number of votes they received.

Here is the list that was voted on:

1. Goodman Ct. drainage
2. Increase maintenance budget and capital improvement plan for playground equipment
3. Additional street department employee
4. Infrastructure
5. Airport expansion
6. Heated storage at street department
7. Replacing booster station on Torrey View
8. Well #9
9. Replace grids for sanitation system
10. New police station
11. New server at police department (for all departments)
12. Code enforcement officer/evidence – full time position
13. Library addition
14. Bike lanes in new construction areas
15. Safe routes to school – increase sidewalk repair
16. Perch Lake restoration

The items in the top 5 were:

1. Full-time code enforcement officer – 10 points
2. Goodman Ct. drainage – 8 points
3. Infrastructure – 8 points
4. Capital Improvements-playground equipment – 7 points
5. Booster station - 6

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The Aldermen and Alderwomen thanked all the department heads for their hard work.
