A motion was made by Sandie Perry and seconded by Deb Moore to approve the minutes from the April 19, 2017 meeting with a change to read red or gold bicycles. Motion carried 6-0.

A motion was made by Janet Horstman and seconded by Cindy Arenz to approve the sign request for Grantie Anne's Studio located at 117 E. Oak Street. Motion carried 6-0.

Chad Needham is requesting sign approval for his business located at 101 S. Water Street. The sign will be 3 ft. wide but samples of the colors or material were not available. **The request for sign approval for Balancing Body Care, LLC is being tabled until Chad Needham has a sample of the colors and material to be used for the sign to be located at 101 S. Water Street. Motion carried 6-0.**

A motion was made by Sandie Perry and seconded by Deb Moore to approve the window replacement request for Chad Needham for business located at 101 ½ S. Water Street. Motion carried 6-0.

Last month, the Commission approved the Chamber of Commerce painting old bikes to be placed in front of some downtown businesses. Janet Horstman wanted this to come back to the Commission to see if other colors could be available. These bikes have already painted, this will be brought up again next year. The businesses could also place a basket on the bikes to fill with flowers or personalize the bike to go along with their business if they would like to. **A motion was made by Kevin Riley and seconded by Janet Horstman to re-consider looking at this again next year and see what colors other businesses would like.
