Jim Church called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Alli Karrels to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of minutes of the September 10, 2018 meeting, Park & Rec Director's monthly report for October, River Run report for September and monthly bills for September. Motion carried 6-0.

Brad went over the equipment replacement list for 2019. He will be selling on the auction site a GMC Sonoma truck and a Chevy Colorado truck and purchasing one vehicle. The plan is also to purchase 2 mid-size utility carts at \$8,000 - \$10,000 each. Also to be purchased are new verticut reels for the greens mower. A couple of members asked if there was a plan set up for regular playground equipment and for all abilities playground equipment. That will be added to the playground equipment plan. **A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Brian Harrie to approve the equipment replacement plan as presented. Motion carried 6-0.**

Bruce Humphrey wanted to discuss the situation with the trees at the Golf Course as he feels some of them are unsafe. Several trees came down in the recent storms in the last couple of months. It would be nice to have someone come and check the trees to see if they are healthy or need to be removed. There was further discussion to particular trees at different areas on the course. **A motion was made by Brian Harrie and seconded by Cori Koch to contact an arborist to see what the cost would be to take a look at the trees at the golf course and some of the parks and get their recommendation. Motion carried 6-0.**

Parks & Recreation Director's Report
January 7, 2019

Wrestling

The program will started on Jan.3, 2019. We have a total of 54 participants signed up at this time. This is down from past years and we hope to have more sign up as the season gets started. Our annual tournament will take place on Sunday, Jan. 20 at the Middle School. We are looking forward to another great season of wrestling. The program will be held at the Old Middle School once again this season to allow for the gymnastics program to utilize the Child Center Gym.

Winter Archery

The winter archery program is again nearly full. We have a few spots left in the advanced classes. Our new instructors have a season under their belt and are doing a great job.

Gymnastics

The program continues to fill up from season to season. We will have some days during this session that we will have to cancel practice due to High School meets. We have these scheduled and families should be aware of the program change.

Youth Basketball

We worked with the Basketball association again this year and offered a 1-2 grade and 3-4 grade basketball programs. We had practices on Wed. nights and the middle school and games were Saturday mornings. There were close to 80 1-2 grade participants and around 60 3-4 grade participants. We will be working with them for the upcoming YMCA Basketball league.

Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament

The tournament is scheduled for Jan. 12th and we currently have 11 teams registered. We are hoping to get 1 more team so we have an even number. We are hosting at the high school and will utilize all 4 of the available courts. This is the same number of teams that we had in 2018.

Women's Volleyball Tournament

The tournament is scheduled for Feb. and we have started to market and advertise for this event.

Special Recreation

We continue to offer craft days and are working on our summer programming. .

Adult Fitness

We have hosted an open house on Jan. 2nd to allow participants to try out classes and hopefully get them to sign up for the entire season.

Golf Course

Most of the guys have been on vacation during the month of December. We will be going full force on routine maintenance after the first of the year.

Miscellaneous

Open Gym continues on Sunday evenings at the Community Center. Attendance has been good so far with an average of 15-20 participants.

We have been cutting down the dead ash trees in the parks and golf course. We have contacted an arborist to do a tree assessment in the spring. They feel it is better to do when tree is actively growing and has leaves on them. We will get approximate count on the number of trees in questions and will get them out early spring to assess the trees on the course.




