Jim Church called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Kevin Brueggeman to approve the consent agenda consisting of the minutes of the August 5, 2019 meeting, and the Police Department's monthly report for July and bills. Motion carried 4-0.

Upon proper payment of any fees, the following new or renewal bartenders licenses were approved on a motion by Josh Lydon and seconded by Ed Lukasek. Motion carried 4-0.

A bartender application was received from Lacy Newbury and is being recommended for denial. Lacy has pending charges against her from a February, 2019 incident. Our ordinance states that an operator's license may be denied for any non-felony drug related convictions or pending charges within the last 12 months. **A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Kevin Brueggeman to deny the bartender application for Lacy Newbury. Motion carried 4-0.**

A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Ed Lukasek to approve the Temporary Class "B" License for Sparta Area of Commerce for Sparta Fall Half Marathon on October 12, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to noon to be located at 111 Milwaukee Street in the Parking Lot. Motion carried 4-0.

An application was received from the Sparta Area Chamber of Commerce for a Temporary Class "B" License for the Sparta Fall Fest on October 12, 2019 in Mueller Square. Chief Kuderer had some concerns regarding their layout of the park for this event. Since last year's event, there have been trees and bushes taken down which makes the access to the park easier. The layout would pass State Statutes, but does not pass the City Ordinance which requires fencing and one entrance and exit should be specified. Now that this area is considered a City Park, no carry-ins would be allowed if a temporary license is approved. The time allocated for this event is 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. There was some discussion on how the items of concern could be handled. **A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Jim Church to approve the Temporary Class "B" license for Sparta Area Chamber of Commerce for Fall Fest on October 12, 2019 in Mueller Square with exceptions to the fencing and exit/entrance rules. Motion carried 2-1-1 with Kevin Brueggeman voting no and Ed Lukasek abstaining.**

An application was received from the Sparta Area of Commerce for a Temporary “Class B” License for Kriskindlmarkt on the dates of Nov. 29 & 30; Dec. 6 & 7; Dec. 13 & 14, 2019 in Mueller Square. Friday hours would be 4:00 – 8:00 p.m. and Saturday hours would be 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Since this event is in Mueller Square just like the Fall Fest, Chief Kuderer had the same concerns. **A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Jim Church to approve the Temporary “Class B” license for Sparta Area Chamber of Commerce for Kriskindlmarkt in Mueller Square with exceptions to the fencing and exit/entrance rules. Motion carried 2-1-1 with Kevin Brueggeman voting no and Ed Lukasek abstaining.**

An application was received from Angelo Francis, the owner of 608 Live Entertainment located at 620 Industrial Drive, Suite 1 for a Class “B” beer license. Chief Kuderer had some concerns about issuing a beer license as they have been called to this place several times because of incidents. The owners rent this place out for private parties and alcohol has been allowed at these parties. There have been bands hired and they charged a cover fee to cover the alcohol. The owners did not completely understand the rules for having alcohol at these parties. However, Chief is requesting that the beer license be approved as it might help to keep things under control once the owners are talked to and explain what they can and can’t allow. **A motion was made by Ed Lukasek and seconded by Kevin Brueggeman to approve the Class “B” license for Angelo Francis dba 608 Live Entertainment located at 620 Industrial Drive, Suite 1. Motion carried 4-0.**

City Attorney Jim Hellman had a draft of a new Ordinance for “Click & Collect” for Alcohol Sales. Wal Mart is now providing a service to their customers where they can order ahead of time and pick up items in a designated area. They would like to include alcohol sales. Since last month’s meeting there were 3 changes to their request. They are changing their waiting period for alcohol orders from 4 hours to 3 hours; changing the hours to 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. to match State laws and a licensed operator much take the order and handle the delivery. **A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Jim Church to approve the Click & Collect ordinance with item b(2) stricken which states that the licenses operator must verify that the person placing the order is the same person picking up the order. Motion carried 2-2 with Ed Lukasek and Kevin Brueggeman voting no. This will be taken to Council for full council to make a vote on this.**

The School District would like to have a sign placed on W. Division Street similar to the sign by Southside School specifying “No Parking” or “Drop off Times”. They would like this in place when the Hermann Elementary School starts up. This item will be referred to the Public Works Board.

There were no items mentioned for future consideration.


A motion was made by Josh Lydon and seconded by Kevin Brueggeman to adjourn at 6:08 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.






2018/2019 Year to Date Calls for Service




2018/2019 Year to Date Citations & Arrests



Year to Date Major Crime Comparison Running Total 2018/2019




Major Crime Comparison August 2018/2019




August 2019 Traffic Stops Warnings/Citations Comparison *

Sec. 12-31. - Revocation of alcohol beverage license for failure to operate business.

- (a) Any holder of an alcohol beverage license issued by the city is required to use the issued license on the premises to which it applies no less than 120 days during the term of the license and at least once every 30 days.
- (b) The city may revoke or refuse to renew the license of any person who fails to use an alcohol beverage license for the minimum period required in subsection (a) of this section. The proceedings for the revocation or such license or refusal to renew such license may be instituted in the manner and under the procedure established in Wis. Stats. § 125.12 and this chapter.
