Jim Church mentioned that he had been in contact with Sharon Nelson regarding COVID-19 and the possibility of opening the Aquatic Center. She told him about a website that health departments from 6 counties report to. It is the Coulee Covid-19 Compass Dashboard and when you go to this site, you are able to see if your county is in a low, moderate, or severe risk area

and what the current guidelines are to follow. A question was asked about the City's liability if the Aquatic Center was open and someone came down with the virus. Attorney Hellman mentioned that if we follow the guidelines set forth from the Health Department and WEDC, we should be fine. There was more discussion opening and/or closing the center. **A motion was made by Jim Church to open the Aquatic Center seconded by Matthew Hoffland. A roll call vote was taken: Jim Church – yes; Kevin Brueggeman – yes; Bruce Humphrey – no; Norm Stanek – no; Matthew Hoffland – yes; Ed Lukasek – no; Josh Lydon – no; Kevin Riley – no. Motion failed 3-5.**

Todd went over the City Administrator Report.

We have been getting lots of calls regarding tree removal. The Street Department is continuing to remove dead trees, but the brush dump is full so they are running out of area to put the brush.

Golden Eagle Roofing is giving back the land to the City that they were interested in.

Brooks Tractor has postponed construction until later this year.

Icecap Road stormwater project should begin soon. Waiting on DNR permits.

City Hall and Municipal buildings have been open since June 1 without any issues.

The bid process will begin in August for the Police Department.

The date for the Committee of the Whole meeting is set for July 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.

There were no items mentioned for future consideration.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHOOL ZONES ORDINANCE**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPARTA, MONROE COUNTY, WISCONSIN,

Section 1: Section 7-94 (Prior Code sec 7.06(8)) of the Code of City Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7-94. - School zones.

(A) No person shall park a motor vehicle and no owner of a motor vehicle shall allow it to be parked for any period of time between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on school days on the following streets and public ways:

- (1) The south side of East Franklin Street from the east line of North Spring Street to the west line of North Benton Street.
  - (2) The west side of North Benton Street from the south line of East Franklin Street to the north line of the driveway of the school parking lot.
  - (3) The east side of South L Street from the north line of West Oak Street to the south line of West Main Street.
  - (4) The west side of South L Street, commencing at the south side of Jefferson Avenue, thence 250 feet south.
  - (5) The south side of Pine Street from the east lot line of the property located at 217 North Rusk Ave. to the east line of the driveway of Lakeview School onto Pine Street.
  - (6) On the following streets and public ways, residential parking only from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. school days only, to-wit:
    - a. North side of West Montgomery Street from North Black River Street to Drake Street.
    - b. South side of West Montgomery Street from Goodman Street to Drake Street.
    - c. Goodman Street, Russell Street, Williams Street and Eyer Street.

  - (8) The West side of L for the first 150 feet North of Oak Street.

WHEREAS, pursuant to sec. 66.1105, Wisconsin Statutes, the Planning Commission, City of Sparta, Monroe County, Wisconsin has held a public hearing on the proposed Project Plan Amendment to Tax Incremental Finance District No. 9 (herein "Project Plan" and "District") on July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 after notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS, prior to publication of notice of said public hearing, a copy of the notice was sent by first class mail to the chief executive officer or administrator of the Sparta School District, Western Technical College, and Monroe County; and

WHEREAS, after the public hearing was held the Plan Commission recommended adoption of the Project Plan Amendment by resolution, subject to the approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Project Plan, which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference, meets all of the following requirements of sec. 66.1105, Wisconsin Statutes, to wit:

- A. Includes a statement listing the kind, number and location of all proposed public works and improvements within such District; and
- B. Contains an economic feasibility study; and
- C. Contains a detailed list of estimated project costs; and
- D. Contains a description of the methods of financing, all estimated project costs, and the time when such costs or monetary obligations related thereto are to be incurred; and
- E. Includes maps showing boundary of the District, existing land use, zoning, future land use, and proposed improvements of real property in such District; and
- F. Includes proposed changes, if any, in zoning ordinances, master plan, map, building codes, and City ordinances; and
- G. Contains a list of estimated non-project costs; and
- H. Contains a statement of the proposed method for the relocation, if any, of persons to be displaced by District projects; and
- I. Contains a statement indicating how creation of the District promotes the development of the City; and
- J. Includes an opinion of the City Attorney advising that the Project Plan is complete and complies with sec. 66.1105, Wisconsin Statutes.

WHEREAS, the City Council makes the following findings:

1. The name of the District shall be "Tax Increment Finance District #9, City of Sparta", a Mixed-Use type district; and
2. The boundaries of the District are described in the attached Project Plan that is incorporated by reference, and such boundaries are contiguous and of sufficient definiteness to identify with ordinary and reasonable certainty the territory included therein. Boundaries include only those whole units of property that are assessed for general tax purposes. The boundaries of the District do not include annexed territory that was not within the boundaries of the City within the last three years; and
3. The boundaries of the District will overlap a portion of existing Tax Increment Finance District #6, City of Sparta; and
4. The creation date of the District for purposes of determining the expenditure and termination periods shall be the date upon which the City Council approves a resolution adopting the Project Plan. For purposes of allocating tax increment the creation date shall be January 1, 2017, amended January 1, 2020; and
5. Not less than 50% of the real property in the District is suitable for mixed-use development, as defined under State Statute §66.1105(2)(cm); and
6. Newly platted residential development, as defined under Wis. Stat. 66.1105, will not exceed 35% of the area in the District; and
7. The City will only allow tax increment revenue to be spent on newly platted residential development in the District if one of the following three applies:
  - Density of the residential housing is at least three (3) units per acre, or
  - Residential housing is located in a conservation subdivision, as defined in sec. 66.1027(1)(a), Wis. Stats., or
  - Residential housing is located in a traditional neighborhood development, as defined in sec. 66.1027(1)(c), Wis. Stats.
8. The estimated percentage of territory within the District that will be devoted to retail business at the end of the maximum expenditure period is not anticipated to exceed 35 percent of the area of the District; and
9. The improvement of such area is likely to enhance significantly the value of substantially all other real property in the District; and
10. The project costs directly serve to promote orderly development consistent with the purposes for which the District is created; and
11. The equalized value of the taxable property of the District plus the aggregate value increment of all existing districts within the City does not exceed 12% of the total value of equalized taxable property within the City; and
12. The Project Plan for the District is feasible; and

13. Improvements to the District are likely to encourage and promote conformity with the City's planning policies and procedures; and

14. The development described in the Project Plan would not occur without the creation of TID #9.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sparta, Monroe County, Wisconsin hereby approves and adopts the Project Plan for Tax Incremental Finance District No. 9 and amends Tax Incremental Finance District No. 9, said Project Plan Amendment being attached and incorporated by reference.
