November 2, 2021

Kevin Riley called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
Roll Call was done by the clerk.

A motion was made by Sandie Perry and seconded by Mike Jamesson to approve the consent agenda consisting of the minutes from the October 5, 2021 meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Number 4 on the agenda was discussed at this time. Joel Tock was listening in on the phone in case there were any questions. The Commission was presented with 2 options for his new sign. One option incorporates lighted LED tubes which would conform to the works "Music Shop". The idea would be to light up the letters as well as illuminating the rest of the semi-transparent colors ("Sparta" and the paintbrush guitar) from behind the sign. The other option would not use LED lights but would still be illuminated from behind the sign. The LED lights would have dimmer capacities to adjust light. Joel is eventually planning on painting the door and power washing the front of the building. **A motion was made by Mike Jamesson and seconded by Kevin Riley to approve the option with the lighted LED lights, preferably red LED's, with the capability of being dimmed if needed. Motion carried 5-0.**

A request was received by Mariah Lopez & Agustin Lopez to replace the awning on the building located at 112 S. Water Street. This will include replacing the fabric and changing the color for the sign to read Super Mercado Oaxaca, Mexican Market. The Lopez's were not at this meeting. **A motion was made by Mike Jamesson and seconded by Deb Moore to approve the coloring and fabric of the replacement awning but to make sure that the letters are straight on the signage. Motion carried 5-0. (Sandie Perry left meeting at this point)**

There were no items mentioned for future consideration.

A motion was made by Deb Moore and seconded by Jennifer Wangen to adjourn at 5:50 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.
