October 12, 2022

Ed Lukasek called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

A motion was made by Sandie Perry and seconded by Mike Jamesson to approve the consent agenda consisting of the minutes from the October 4, 2022 meeting. Motion carried 4-0.

Mike Kidd of Prestige Furniture was unable to attend the meeting due to a work commitment. The committee discussed at length the signage proposed by Mike of Prestige Furniture. They were concerned that the signage was too large for the awning and wall space. It was suggested that the awning signage be reduced to have a framed look and that the other two signs have a framed look as well. Todd Fahning told the committee that the signage fits within the ordinance and that the committee cannot ask individuals to change their established logo. The committee understood the urgency of the request and agreed that the sign to be placed on the building wall of Water Street should be approved. They suggested the owner return to a future meeting to either hear the committee's suggestions or present revisions.

A motion was made by Mike Jamesson and seconded by Jennifer Wangen to approve the one sign design to be placed on the Water Street wall and to postpone the approval for the two remaining signs for Prestige Furniture located at 119 S Water Street. Motion carried 4-0.

Items for future consideration were:

It was asked if the ordinances for the Historic District are on the city's website. Todd stated that they are.

There is concern that a few businesses in the Historic District have made modifications to their buildings without prior application and approval from this committee.

A motion was made by Mike Jamesson and seconded by Jennifer Wangen to adjourn at 5:55 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.


